Exceptional GMOs are authorized to apply, and will complete the full 24 month program at WPAFB. Two positions will be available for training at University of Texas Medical Branch (UTMB) for space-focused training for applicants with prior board certification, and will complete the full 24 month program at UTMB. Applicants seeking training with UTMB must complete all of the UTMB pre-requisites prior to initiating training.

2: Must have a minimum of 18 months experience as a Flight Surgeon, and have successfully completed a prior internship to apply. The full 48 months of training will be completed at WPAFB. Applicants seeking training in the FAM/RAM must complete all of the WSU Family Medicine residency pre-requisites prior to initiating training
