The Chestnut Hill College Institutional Review Board has reviewed your submission with regard to your proposal, *How prepared are wrap-around practitioners to provide trauma informed care*, and we are pleased to notify you of IRB approval to proceed with this project. In accordance with federal IRB guidelines, a proposal is approved for exactly one calendar year.
