Pre-Professional Health Academic Program (PHAP)

PHAP is not an aid-eligible program. But under a federal exception, PHAP students have limited eligibility for federal loans if they are enrolled in at least 6 units of prerequisite courses needed for future admission to an academic program in the health professions.

Limited Aid Eligibility: Plan Your Finances

Maximum Loan Eligibility: Plan Your Finances

<p>Annual Maximum for Dependent: \$5,500</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • up to \$5,500 for Subsidized • up to \$5,500 for Subsidized + Unsubsidized <p>Aggregate Maximum for Dependent: \$31,000</p> <p>Students with lots of previous student loan debt might have little or no remaining eligibility.</p>	<p>Annual Maximum for Independent: \$12,500</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • up to \$5,500 for Subsidized • up to \$12,500 for Subsidized + Unsubsidized <p>Aggregate Maximum for Independent: \$57,500</p> <p>Students with lots of previous student loan debt might have little or no remaining eligibility.</p>

Correct Answers to Key FAFSA Questions: Plan Your Finances

<p>PHAP Students Are Not Graduate Students</p> <p>For PHAP students, the correct answers to FAFSA questions about program and grade level are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Question-47 = No; not working on a master’s or doctorate • Question-29 = 5th year/other undergraduate; not taking graduate-level coursework • Question-30 = Certificate of < 2 yrs –or– Certificate of 2+ yrs; depends on student’s individual plan <p>No on Question-47 Might Indicate a Dependent Student</p> <p>A student answering No on Question-47 might be dependent depending on age and marital status.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For dependent students, FAFSA parent information is required and dependent loan limits apply • Dependent students are offered a credit-based Parent Plus Loan option • If a parent applies for and is denied the Parent Plus Loan option based on adverse credit history, a dependent student can borrow \$12,500 just like an independent student

Aid-Ineligible Non-Degree Programs

Students pursuing a program objective listed below are **NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL LOANS**. However, these non-degree credential programs are eligible for aid: multiple subject, single subject, preliminary education specialist, education specialist internship, pupil personnel services, and internship in administrative services.
